Towards this goal, HIGICC awards a \$1,000 scholarship each year to reward deserving students who show an appreciation for and understanding of geography and geographic information systems (GIS).

Eligibility Criteria

Must study geospatial data or GIS. Eligible students include those pursuing a bachelors, masters, or PhD degree.

- 1) Resume: Include work, education, and volunteer history, including honors and certifications.
- 2) An essay, no longer than 500 words in length, describing your experience with geospatial data, either academically, professionally, or personally, and how you hope to use geospatial data to achieve your future goals. Please provide examples of products you have worked on such as maps, analysis, screen captures of web tools, etc.
- 3) Two letters of recommendation, at least one from an instructor who gave a grade to applicant.
- 4) Transcripts current to time of application (photocopies or unofficial transcripts are acceptable).

Please include all application materials in a single pdf document with the following naming convention: LASTNAME_FIRSTNAME_HIGICC_SCHOLARSHIP.pdf

Publications on HIGICC Website: Submitted essays may be posted on the HIGICC website. The completed presentations, photographs and / or documents may be posted on HIGICC website at a later date.
